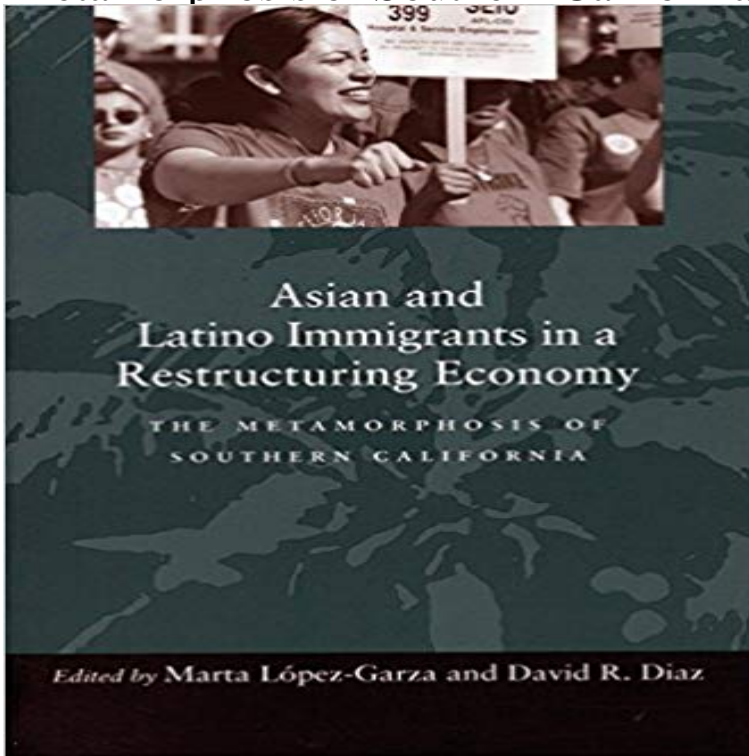


Asian and Latino Immigrants in a Restructuring Economy: The Metamorphosis of Southern California
