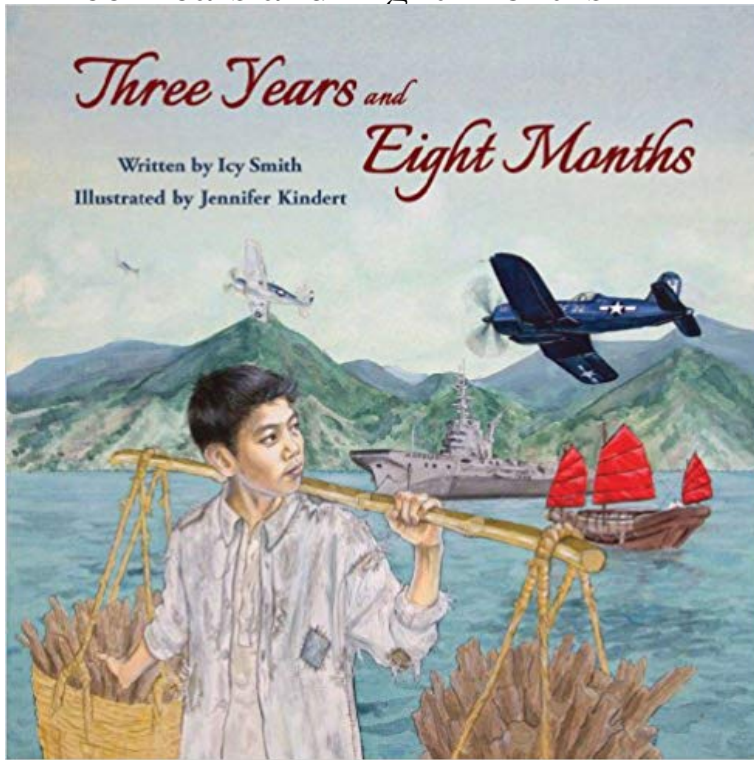


Three Years and Eight Months
