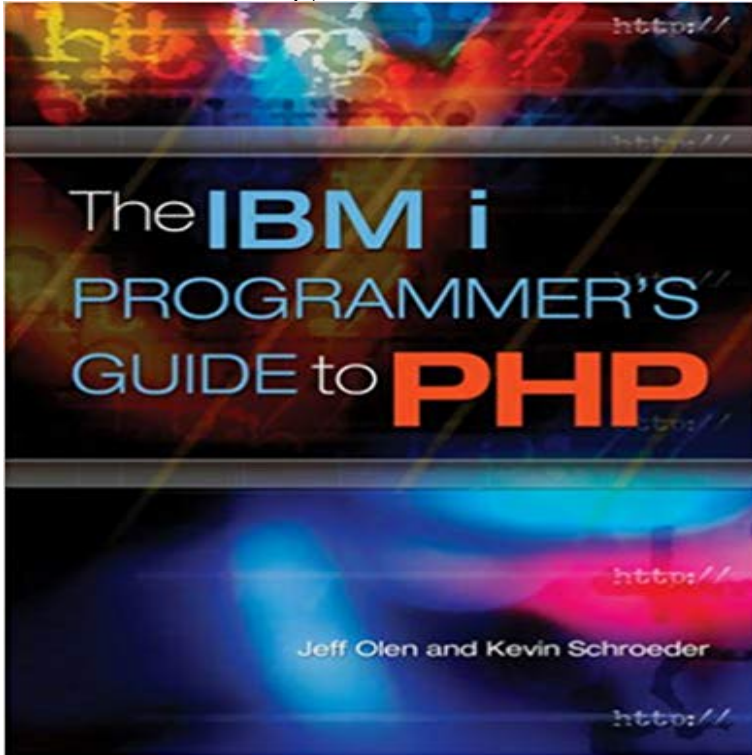


The IBM i Programmers Guide to PHP
