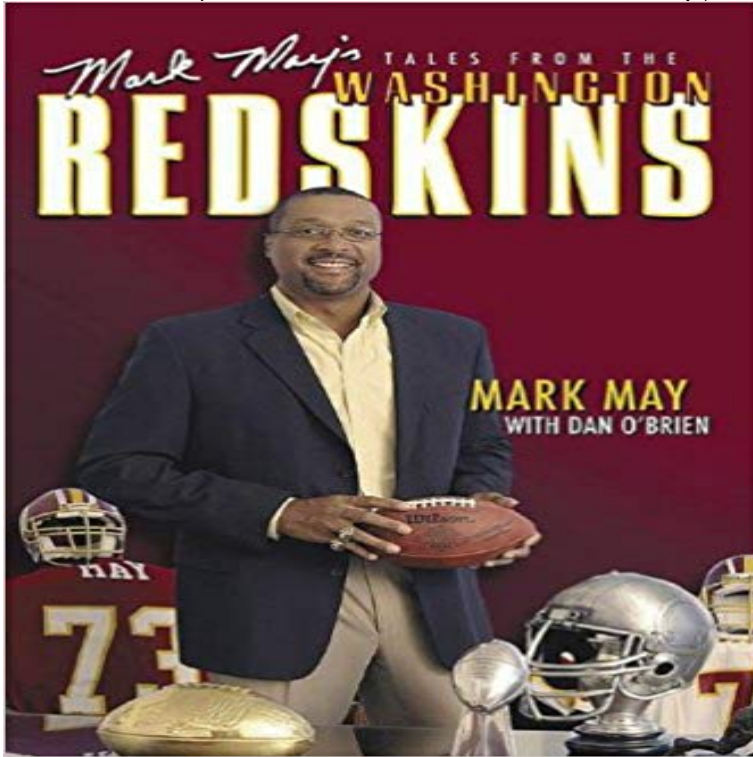


Mark Mays Tales from the Washington Redskins
