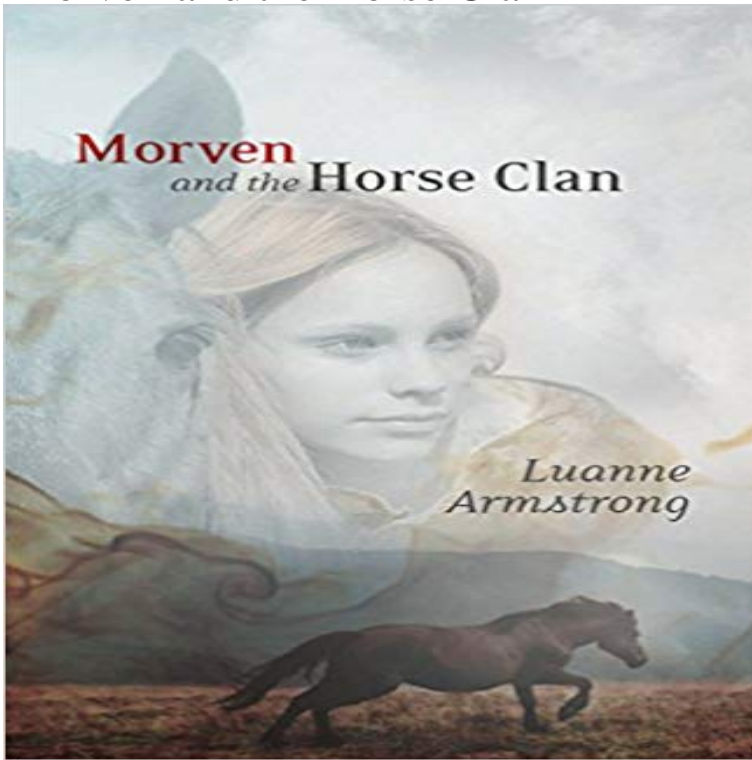


Morven and the Horse Clan
