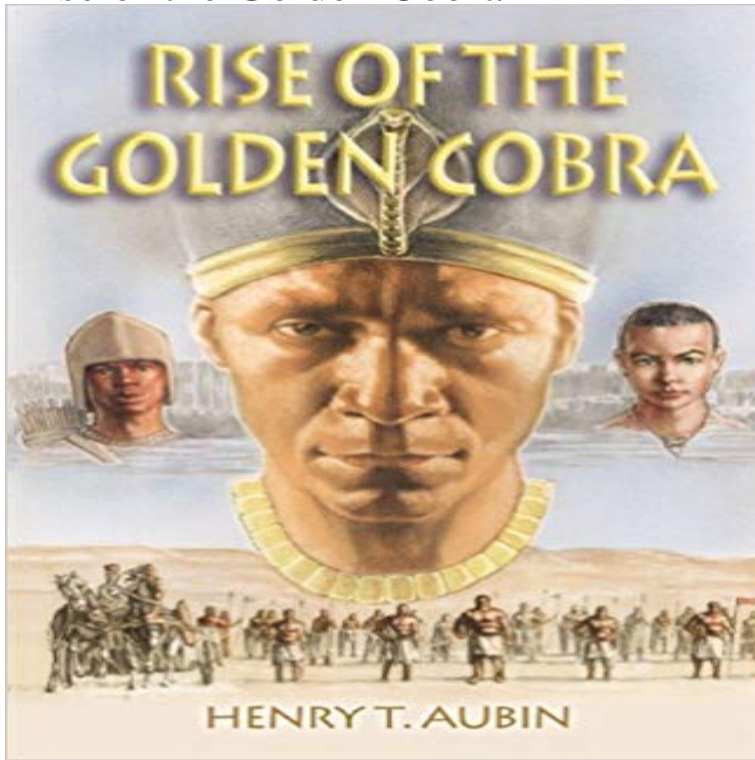


Rise of the Golden Cobra
