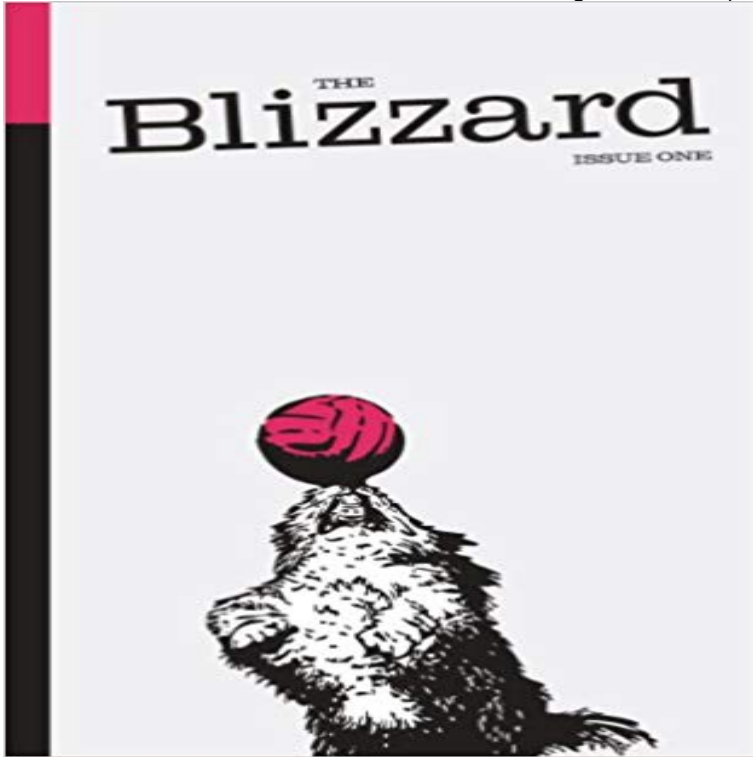


The Blizzard - The Football Quarterly: Issue One
