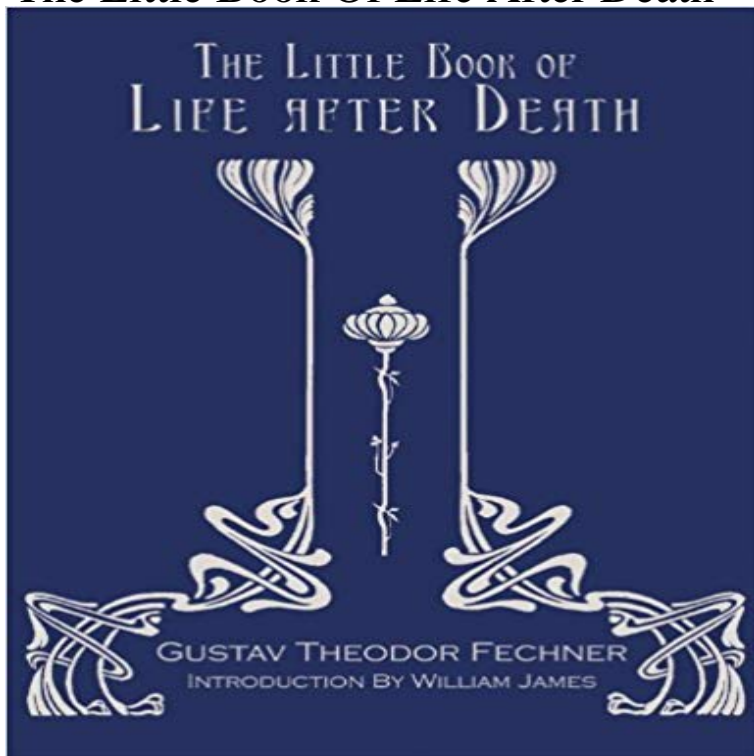


The Little Book Of Life After Death
